INDEPENDENT AMERICA: THE SEARCH FOR MOM & POP

This 80-minute documentary feature follows Emmy Award-winning journalist Hanson Hosen and his partner Heather Hughes, as they hit the road and travel 21,000 kilometers through 32 states in search of "Independent America." It's a place populated by hardy souls fighting for the right to remain independent in a land smothered by Big Box stores and fast food chains.

The film uncovers a growing movement toward "local" in communities across the country. The filmmakers speak to economists, activists, political leaders, union members, entrepreneurs, and concerned Americans from all walks of life. They also have a frank conversation with a top executive from the planet's retail overlord: Wal-Mart.
